The City of Rockville is hosting several events this fall that may be of interest to residents:

1. Community Health Fair – Saturday September 20, 2008 from 9am to 1pm at Monroe Street and Route 28. It will be held in conjunction with the Rockville Farmers Market. The fall health fair will focus on women's health issues. The fair will feature a mix of health-oriented vendors and free health screenings for blood pressure, body fat, vision and bone density. Additional health information will be available. There is no cost to attend this event.
2. Second Annual Uncorked – Saturday September 27, 2008 from Noon to 6pm in the Square and costs \$10 per person. This wine and music festival will feature wines from Maryland, cooking demonstrations, wine seminars and musical entertainment. The first 2,000 attendees will receive a commemorative wine glass. You must be 21 or older with valid to drink.
3. Citizens Police Academy – Wednesdays beginning September 17, 2008 through November 19, 2008 from 6:30-9pm. The Rockville Citizens Police Academy offers citizens the opportunity to learn about the police department, various aspects of police work and a chance to get to know officers.
